- Become friends with your owner's manual. It all starts here! Your manual can answer basic questions, help you locate things on your car, and provide a recommended maintenance schedule.

- Inspect your wiper blades. Wiper blades (front and rear) should be smooth and flexible to maintain contact with your windshield. If you see cracks or if the rubber is hard, it's time to have them checked or replaced.

Be sure to regularly check the headlights, tail lights, brake lights, and turn signals to make sure they're working properly. If they aren't, it's time for a new bulb or fuse.

- Keep an eye on your tires. If you see (or feel) bumps anywhere on the tire, if the edges are worn smooth, if a tire can't maintain its recommended pressure, it's time for a tire check with one of AutoCamp's tire experts.
